You can find a wide assortment of decorative clocks in any watch shop. However, the excusive really valued things are extremely rare. The decorative hand-made clock performed in the embroidery manner will beautify your room complementing the home comfort and will be an appreciated gift for your relatives.

I suggest performing such a clock from the old carton clock face 30 cm in diameter.



### **Dina's Art Works**

#### Mosaic, Decoupage, Painting





Put the clock face over a fabric, stroke its contour and outline the place for the clockwork and arrows.



"Turn on" your imagination and draw various flowers, leaves, twigs, berries and so on. It can be both real and fantastic plants.



Embroider with any threads. If you are able to make various kinds of stitches and knots, it'll decorate the embroidery.



Don't afraid to draw with threads over the fabric. Bravely mixing different colors try to achieve a volumetric picture.

# **Dina's Art Works**

#### Mosaic, Decoupage, Painting





Accurately cut the ready embroidery remaining a little fabric for a crease. Glue it over the clock face with a non-liquid glue (moisture can damage your embroidery) and remain for drying.



Pierces a hole at the center of the embroidery and insert the clock mechanism. The eyelet for the clock hanging is at the back side of the mechanism. Expose the exact time and admire the works of your hands.
